It covers core SDG themes such as **Clean Water and Sanitation (SDG 6)**, **Affordable and Clean Energy (SDG 7)**, **Sustainable Cities and Communities (SDG 11)**, **Climate Action (SDG 13)**, **Life Below Water (SDG 14)**, and **Life on Land (SDG 15)**.

Students engage in laboratory and fieldwork, environmental impact assessments, and community-based learning that link theory with applied sustainability solutions. The program has earned accreditation from the **Philippine Accrediting Association of Schools, Colleges and Universities (PAASCU)**, confirming its quality and relevance.
